SURREALISTS IN WALES UNEQUIVOCALLY SUPPORT THE UKRAINIANS IN THEIR STRUGGLE!!

Complicated situations require complicated analysis, and complicated analysis requires complicated words... Complicated or otherwise - these are ours:

All wars exploit and destroy the working classes, whilst making big bucks for the capitalists. That said, a Gandhi figure could not have defeated Hitler... To simply be against war, however, is not sufficient. If I have a cold I get a runny nose – it is pointless my being against runny noses though, or try to prevent getting a runny nose; that is missing the point, I must take measures to avoid catching a cold. The same with war – to be against war and not against capitalism will never stop the running nose.

Let us be clear - we Surrealists in Wales condemn all actions by Putin and his far-right, Great Russian cronies in their imperialistic capitalist invasion of an independent nation. Just as Thatcher was a war criminal and just as her bastard offspring Blair was a war criminal so is Putin - we already have plenty of evidence of the barbarism of his imperial aggression: massacre, wholesale destruction of civilian areas and the use of rape and torture - and we state unequivocally that Putin and his gangsters should be sent to the Hague and tried.

Here and Now

As surrealists and internationalists we are against the idea of the Nation State (as we are against the Church and so much more!), but in the here and now we stand wholeheartedly with the Ukrainians in their defence of their sovereignty. That said, we find it somewhat ratcheted up to fever pitch the hatred that the West has shown for Russia and Russians. Russia is not Putin; Russia, as with everywhere else, comprises exploited struggling-to-survive working class people who are misled by their autocratic oligarch rulers. The West's enthusiasm for defending Ukraine (of course, it is right to defend it) is at least in part due to its subconscious (or not) desire to have revenge for Soviet days; and never allow the possibility of Socialism (which it was not) having a chance to take hold once again. However, we support arming the Ukrainian people in their struggle whilst, of course, providing no political support to NATO and Western capitalism. We fervently await the day when our accounts are settled with them!! Now, lives must be saved and the slaughter must cease immediately. We say:

Stop Putin's War of Aggression!
Self-determination for Ukraine!
Open the Borders - Refugees Are Welcome Here!


It Is Dusk in the Border Town...

It is dusk in the border town Leaves float upwards The sun and the moon sit happily next to each other in the sky


It is dusk in the border town Stealing butterflies for the ceremony of the Moontide Waves caught in the abyss of choosing


