#### ONCE UPON A TOMORROW/UN TRO YFORY SURREALISM IN WALES, THE GLOBE, HAY ON WYE, 9 APRIL 2023

The largest surrealist event in the UK, and certainly in Cymru/Wales for many years, was attended by many of the active surrealists from the UK in April. Equally, if not more importantly, it was attended by many people who were simply curious as to the nature of the this radical & subversive moment called surrealism. The event was held in an old Welsh Chapel and as well as a series of presentations, featured a one-day exhibition of work from the Welsh Tribe of Surrealists, curated by Tracy Thursfield & John Welson.

John Richardson, opened the event speaking yn Gymraeg (in Welsh) in public for the first time, setting the tone for what was to come proclaiming that surrealism is here, relevant, emancipatory & is a worldview concerned with re-enchanting the world with 'what can be' rather than 'what is'. He went on to note the coincidence of the venue and date (it was easter sunday) with the famous provocation staged by the Lettrist Movement at Notre Dame in 1953, repeating, from the pulpit, some of Michel Mourre's words as an act of homage. The event was up and running!!

Then it was **John Welson's** turn who presented Surrealism is Dead, Long Live Surrealism! He swirled our consciousnesses through the beautiful mystery & revolutionary alchemical adventure that is surrealism, explaining 'what it is' and 'what it is not'.

**Jean Bonnin** followed with a survey of *Surrealism in Wales* (see his indispensable book of the same name) taking in our history, radicalism, mystery, art & poetry along with music and cinema. We had the surrealism of *Y Ddraig Goch* (The Red Dragon)!!

The session *Surrealist Cinema*, including films by Ian Walker; Taya King; Darren Thomas; Neil Coombs; & Jean Bonnin, was introduced, explained & caressed delicately by **Darren Thomas** (with help from **Taya King**). The final session, Beyond the Limits of Reason: Surrealist Poetry, introduced by JR, saw Jean; Steve Handsaker; Tracy; Darren; John W; & JR complete the proceedings with a 15 minute spurts of poetry. A closing speech, more convivial conversation with surrealist friends and comrades from Scotland, Leeds, Liverpool (Surrealerpool), Bristol, Stoke, Telford, the South East & elsewhere and we were done!

Say who you would send the postcard to and what your message would be.


I would send the postcard to my younger self, saying: this is for Jean from your future wife Beryl...(JB)

Rafael Sabatini's black cape caught in Clifford's breeze. (JW)








